A: Your first resource for getting a referee is to review your club's meet package from the previous year and talk to parents that have been with the club for awhile. Often referees from previous years may be able to make themselves available to help you out again this year. Your second resource is your Region Representative. He or she will be familiar with senior officials in your region and can recommend one for you. Failing these sources, you can contact the [ASSA Officials Chair](#). He or she will be able to forward you a list of referees for you to contact.
